

# TRAVEL FORM

As you are planning your travel, please remember that Americo FCU employs a fraud monitoring service to combat debit and credit card fraud. If a debit card transaction is out of your normal spending habits, you may receive a call asking you if you made the purchase. If we cannot get a hold of you, a temporary block may be placed on your account until we can verify the transactions in question with you.

This is one reason it is important that we have your current cell phone number or a phone number that we are able to reach you during your travel.
