MAKE A LOAN PAYMENT THROUGH MESSAGEPAY

We want to make things easier for you! Make a payment to your Americo Federal Credit Union loans or credit cards from any external account. MessagePay is the quick, easy way to make a payment to your Americo Federal Credit Union loans or credit cards from any external account. You can pay from your smart phone, tablet, laptop, or home computer.

How MessagePay Works

- Once you sign up for MessagePay, you'll get a text message informing you of the amount due on your loan. You'll be able to review your payment options, or you can opt out of our text message service by texting "STOP."
- The link will take you to a portal where you will be asked to verify your account with your account number and date of birth.

Account Lookup First Time Users

The first time you visit our MessagePay payment portal you will need to authenticate your account with your account number and date of birth. Next, you will be asked to set a four digit PIN. This PIN will be used to make subsequent payments.

Add a Payment Method

First time users will need to add payment methods to your account. Select "Methods" on the top menu. From this screen you can add new cards or bank accounts to pay from. You can add multiple methods and select which method you would like to be your "default" payment method.

Make a Payment

Once you've added a payment method, you can visit the "Payment" screen to make your payment (\$4 convenience fee). To make your payment in full, select the blue "Make Payment Now" button. To edit your payment amount, you can touch the pencil icon to the right of the amount. (Partial payments may result in a late fee.) You can also select a different payment method by touching the pencil icon to the right of the select method. Upon selecting "Make Payment Now," a confirmation screen is shown to confirm that you want to make the payment with the selected method.

Set Up Recurring Payments

You can set up your recurring payment in four simple steps.

- Login
- Click 'Schedule My Payment' button
- Fill out Payment Schedule
- Confirm Schedule Creation


That's it! Your new recurring payment is set up.

Text to Pay

We will text out reminders for past due loan payments. If you have previously used the MessagePay payment portal, you will be able to text the word "Pay" and enter your four digit PIN to make your payment. It's as easy as that!

FRAUD - HOW TO IDENTIFY SCAMS

While social networks allow people to easily connect with each other and share information, they are also a hotbed for fraudulent activity. Here are tips for spotting potential fraud scams on social media:

- Review the account: Social media profiles from legitimate companies include specific details about the company or organization. Be cautious of accounts with incomplete profiles, very few posts or suspicious profile pictures.
- Do some research: With any offer that seems too good to be true, the best practice is to be cautious. If you aren't sure the post is legitimate, don't click on the link in the social media post. Search for the offer or the company online to verify its legitimacy.
- Don't trust unsolicited messages: If someone you don't know contacts you through a social media channel, be cautious interacting with them. It's best to be suspicious of their intentions and not engage. And you should never share personal information or passwords even with people you know.
- Be wary of friend requests: Scammers often try to connect with people on social media so they can interact with them directly. You should never accept friend requests from someone you don't know. And if you receive a friend request from someone you're already connected with, contact them immediately to let them know they may have been hacked.

Consumers should be on high alert when using social media. The safest thing you can do is be suspicious of anything that sounds too good to be true, even if it appears to come from someone you know.
