FRAUD ALERT

The Pennsylvania State Police is alerting the public of scams involving individuals claiming to be from computer tech support.

Individuals are receiving an increased number of these types of scam messages and phone calls. Scammers use fake browser pop-ups or unsolicited phone calls to trick victims into believing their computer is infected or compromised. Scammers then try to gain remote access to your device to install malware, steal personal information, steal financial information, or demand payment for nonexistent problems. Scammers will use many tactics to sound and appear credible. If you suspect a scam, do not give out any personal information, hangup and contact your local law enforcement.

How the scam works

Fake pop-ups: You might see a full-screen pop-up or a "locked" screen message that looks like a legitimate Microsoft alert, often with a siren sound.

Call to action: This message instructs you to call a provided phone number to "fix" a serious issue, like an IP address being used for illegal activity or a virus being found.

Remote access: If you call the number, a scammer will try to convince you to install remote access software to give them control of your computer.

Information and payment: Once they have access, they'll pretend to find problems on your computer, steal your personal data, and demand money, often in the form of cryptocurrency or gift cards.

How to protect yourself

Never trust unsolicited contact: Microsoft will never contact you by phone or email to offer technical support.

Don't call numbers from fake pop-ups: Real Microsoft error messages do not include phone numbers to call.

Disconnect immediately: If your screen is locked or you're on a call with a suspected scammer, unplug your network cable or turn off your Wi-Fi to cut off their access.

Report the scam: Report scam to your local law enforcement.

Forced shutdown: If the browser is frozen, try to close it or force-restart your computer by holding the power button.

Our Credit Boost Loan was created specifically to help repair damaged credit, build credit history, and help our members during trying financial times. Our loans are calculated for a 12 month repayment period with an APR* of 18.00% and an application fee of just \$20.00. Loan amounts range from \$500.00 to \$1,000.00. Our members are also encouraged to save with the 10% required deposit held in your Shares account. Could you benefit from our Credit Boost Loan? Talk to our loan department today!

*Annual Percentage Rate. Minimum loan amount is \$500 – Maximum loan amount is \$1000. Borrower must be a member of the Credit Union in good standing for at least six (6) months. Limit of three (3) Credit Boost loans during a six (6) month time frame per member, and you may only borrow one Credit Boost loan at a time. Must provide proof of income. Minimum income of \$1000/month is required. *APR is set at 18%. Estimated monthly payment on \$1,000.00 borrowed at 18.00% *APR for 12 months is \$91.70. There is a \$20 non-refundable application fee (payable with application or added to the principal of the loan).

Just a reminder that if you will temporarily be away from your home, but want to receive your credit union mail at an alternate address, **YOU MUST NOTIFY US IN WRITING.** Simply stop by the credit union, mail or fax your information to us. Include your alternate address, the date you will be leaving and the date you will return, as well as a good contact number. Be sure to notify us when you return home so we can change your account back to your permanent address. **Forward orders through USPS alone will result in returned statements (account and Mastercard).**
